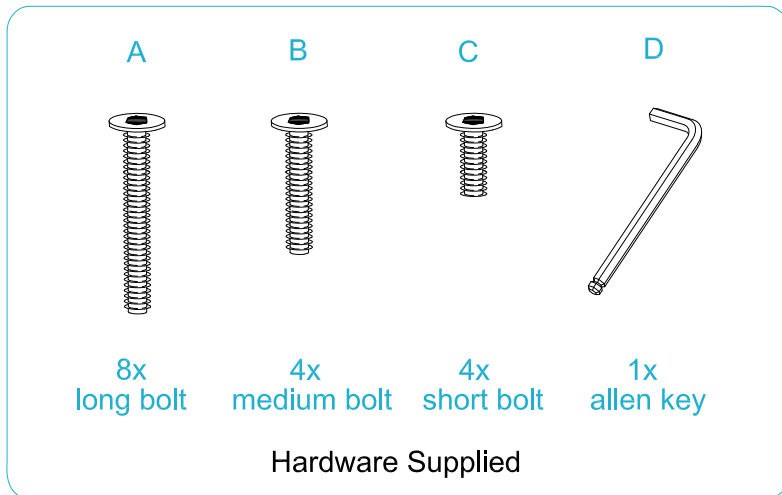

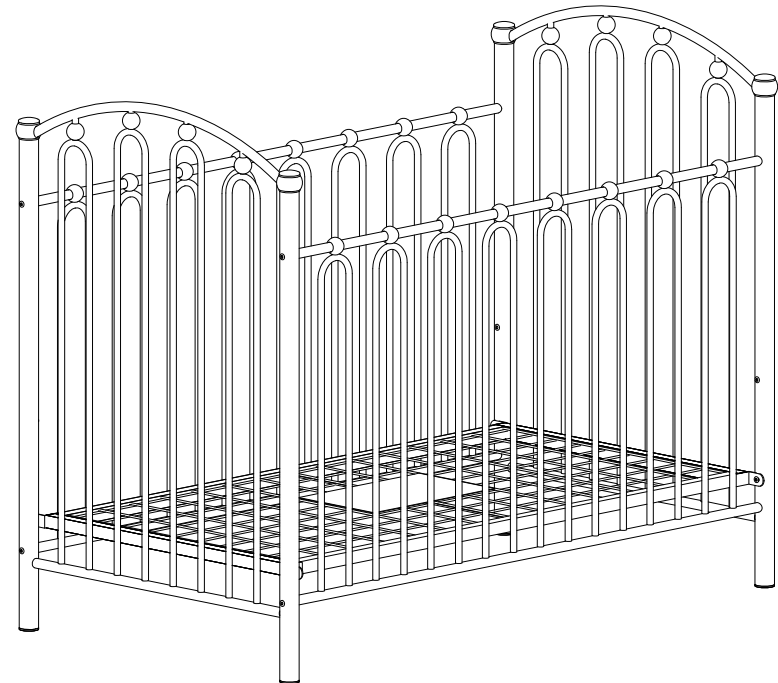

## Assembly Instructions

**Please follow the manufacturer's assembly instructions in detail to ensure the safety features of the cot are not compromised.**

Ensure the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points. Keep all medications, string, elastic, small toys or small items, such as money, out of reach from any position in the cot.

### Assembly

Care must be taken when attaching sides. Ensure all screws are 100% tight before use, but do not over-tighten screws as this can cause damage to the cot. Once assembled lift furniture into place, do not drag.

### Care and Maintenance

Regularly check all screws for tightness or damage that could render the cot unsafe. To clean, use a damp cloth, avoiding the use of detergents or abrasives.

### RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 690 mm wide by 1300 mm long and 100 mm in thickness. The width and length are specified because it is important that gaps between

The mattress and the sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40mm when the mattress is pushed to one side or end, and 20 mm when the mattress is centered in the cot. This is to minimize the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimize the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

### Mattress Position

Upper level-highest position to be used by newborns, until shortly before they can sit alone. Under no circumstances should the mattress be in highest position after the child can sit up.

Lower Level-The mattress base must be in its lowest position before the baby can sit or stand.

**! WARNING: TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MATTRESS BASE OF THIS COT SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO THE LOWEST POSITION BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP.**

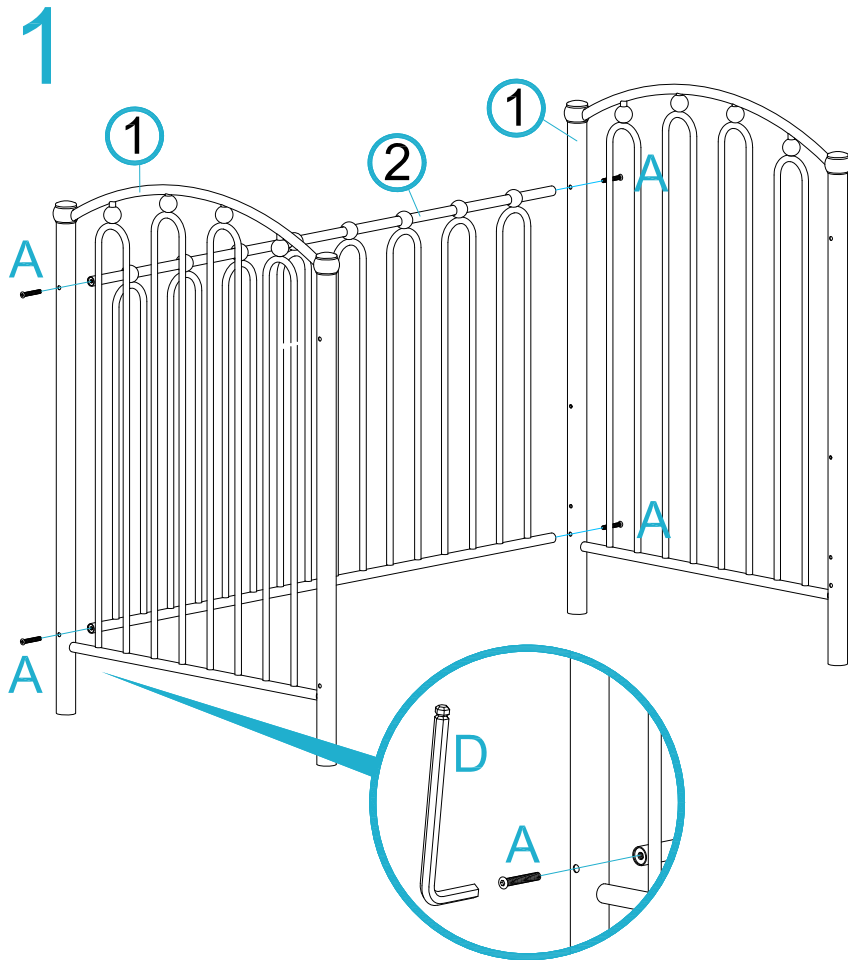

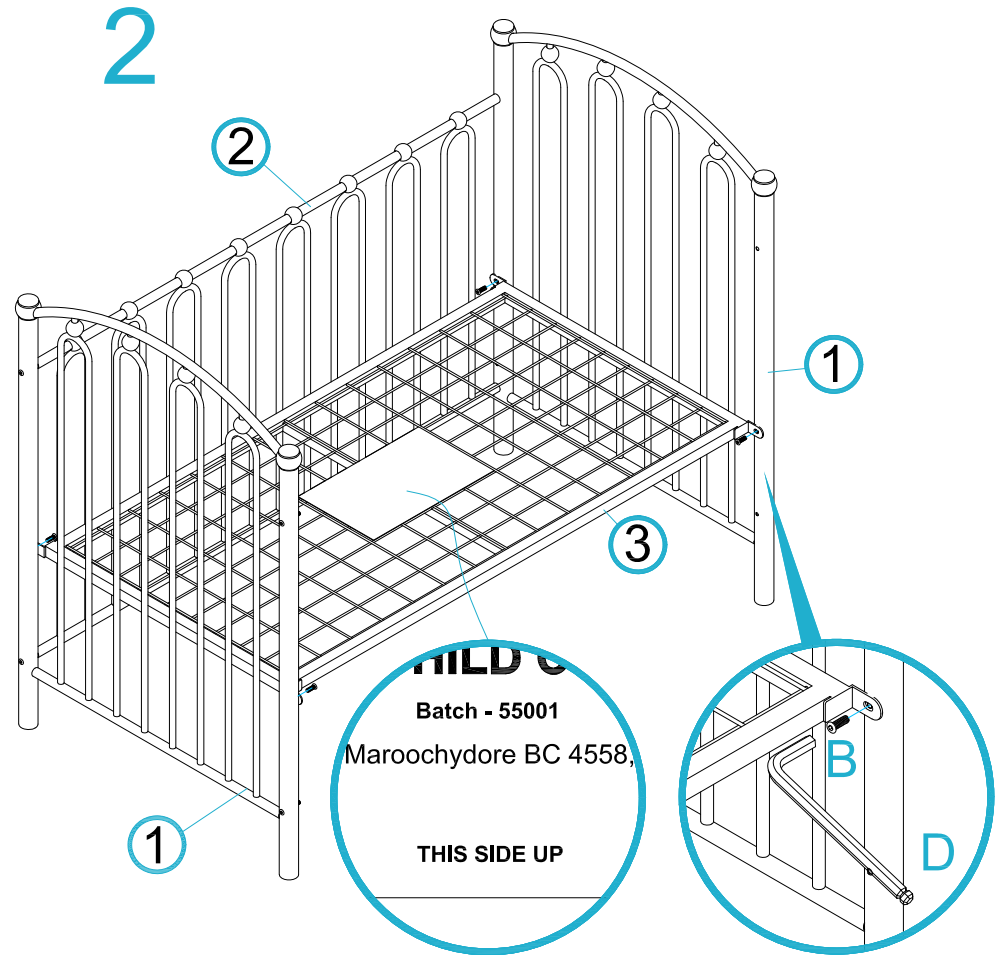

Attach the end 2x panels [1] to side panel [2] using 4x long bolts (A) and secure with the allen key (D).

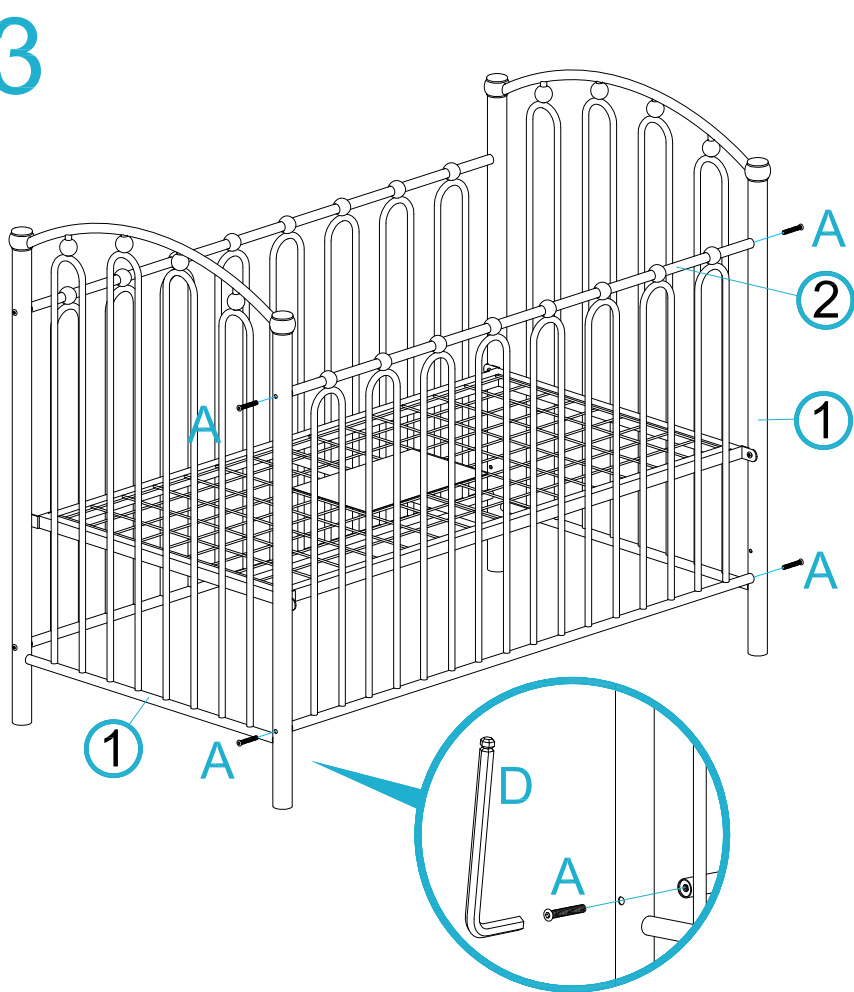


Attach base panel [3] to the rest of the frame using 4x medium bolts (B) and tighten with the allen key (D) as shown. Ensure you follow the directions for the correct mattress support height for your child on Page 2.

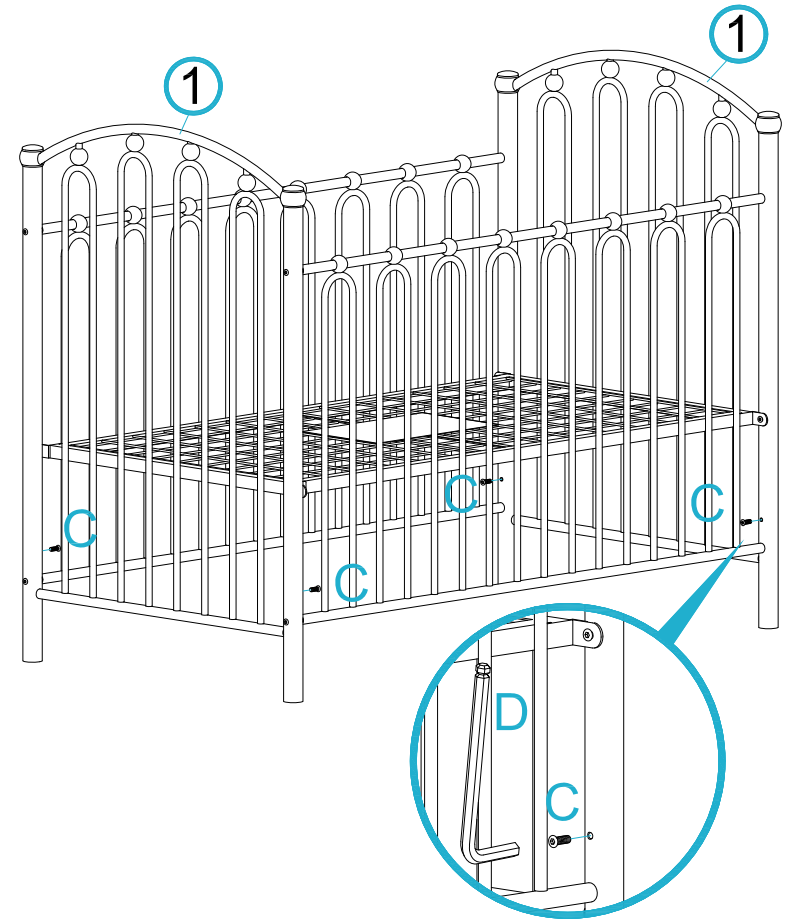

Attach side panel [2] to end panels [1] using 4x long bolts (A) and tighten with the allen key (D).

Place 4x short bolts (C) into the spare holes on both panels [1] as shown, and tighten with an allen key. Ensure the bolts are 100% tight before use. Lift furniture into the desired location, do not drag. You're done, enjoy!
