Thank you for your purchase. Please follow the manufacturer's assembly instructions in detail to ensure the safety features of the cot are not compromised.



Ensure the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points. Keep all medications, string, elastic, small toys or small items, such as money, out of reach from any position in the cot.


ASSEMBLY

Care must be taken when attaching sides. Do not over-tighten screws as this can cause damage to the cot.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Regularly check all screws for tightness or damage that could render the cot unsafe. To clean - use a damp cloth, avoiding the use of detergents or abrasives.

BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP




RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE

This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measures 1300mm long x 690mm wide x 100mm in thickness. The width and length are specified because it is important that gaps between the mattress and the sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40mm when the mattress is pushed to one side or end, and 20mm when the mattress is centred in the cot. This is to minimize the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimize the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.


Attach panels [1] to panels [2] and secure with 8 x screws (A). Tighten with an Allen Key (E).

Attach assembled panels together with panel [3] and secure with 4 x screws (A). Tighten with an Allen Key (E).




Attach panel [4] to assembled frame as shown and secure with 4 x screws (B). Attach 4x screws(C) to 4x nuts(D). Tighten with an Allen Key (E).



Attach panel [3] to assembled frame as shown and secure with $4\ x$ screws (A). Tighten with an Allen Key (E).





LIFT THE COT INTO PLACE, DO NOT DRAG, AS THIS CAN CAUSE DAMAGE

OPTIONAL/MATTRESS HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT (please keep these instructions handy for future reference)

To adjust mattress base settings, remove screws(C) and nuts (D). Repeat steps 2, 3 and 4 by removing the side panel and moving the base to corresponding holes. Securely attach again in the adjusted position.
